

Permanent Absent Voter Application List

The Northville City Clerk's Office maintains a list of voters that are interested in receiving an Absent Voter Ballot **application** for every election.


There are no requirements to be placed on the list. However you must meet 1 of the following requirements to receive a ballot:

- ➢ 60 years of age or older
- Physically unable to attend polls
- ➤ Absent from community on Election Day
- > Appointed as Precinct worker at a precinct outside your precinct of residence
- Cannot attend polls because of tenets of my religion
- Confined to jail awaiting arraignment or trial

If this appeals to you, complete the form and return it to: Office of the City Clerk, City of Northville, 215 W. Main Street, Northville, MI 48167. (You may also use the 24-hour drop box located in the City Hall vestibule)

After returning this form, you will automatically receive an absent voter **application** prior to every election. If you choose to return the completed application, the Clerk's office will send you a ballot.

If you wish to vote at the polls, simply do not complete or return the application you receive for that specific election.
