**New Business**

**A. Public Accuracy Test**

The Election Commission chose Precinct 1 AV as the test precinct. An explanation was provided pertaining to the logic testing ballot chart and how the test ballots were marked. The ballots were marked in accordance with the test procedures provided by the State Bureau of Elections. The public accuracy test was conducted and the vote totals were reviewed.

A zero report was printed, indicating there were no votes cast. The test ballots were tabulated and the test results matched the logic testing ballot chart. The machine was zeroed out and another zero report was printed. The test ballots, public accuracy test results, and corresponding paperwork were placed under seal.

**Discussion**

The City Clerk noted that it has been difficult to determine the voter turnout and staffing levels needed for this election. Absent Voter Ballot turnout has been low. The Bureau of Elections has suggested turnout to be close to the voter turnout from the November 2014 election. The County Clerk's have suggested turnout will be much lower. Securing Election Inspectors has been difficult as many are on vacation.

Being no further business to come before the Election Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
