Meeting Called to Order

The meeting was called to order at 8:06 by Vice Chairperson Sandra Larson.

The minutes from the May meeting were approved.

Program Report

Director Sue Campbell reported that the mentor-mentee garden has finally been planted at Thayer's Corner Nature Center. Challenge Day at Hillside was a success, as usual. CAMP (Children Adjusting to Middle School Program) Hillside and Camp Meads Mill is filling quickly.

Financial Report

Sue presented a year-to-date financial report. At the conclusion of this calendar year, we expect our fund balance to be around \$96,000. We started with \$104,265. This is pretty close to what we had planned. Similarly, the Conrad Charitable Fund (also included in our Fund Balance Analysis) will be around \$26,000 after committing close to \$15,000 in camp scholarships this year. The Commission was comfortable with this number.

When transitioning in to a discussion of the 2016 proposed budget, Commissioner Roth asked about the large percentage of fund balance relative to our overall budget. Commission members expressed their commitment to maintaining programs and service levels, utilizing the fund balance to do so if necessary. It was agreed by the Commission that the subject would be addressed in the annual Budget discussion with the Township Manager and Finance Director. Any Commissioner available to attend that meeting is welcome. It will be held on August 5, 2015, time TBD.

Commissioner Roth made a motion to keep the program budget at \$23,000 instead of the proposed \$18,300 Director Campbell presented. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
